- A new, brighter light and security camera were recently installed at the 24/7 recycling bins located at the Village DPW Maintenance Building in Thompsonville.
- Earth Day events:

- The Transfer Station in Thompsonville accepts trash on Fridays (fee involved). Call 378-4657.
- As a reminder, never put trash or construction material in a recycling bin. That is illegal dumping; the county will prosecute violators.
